She meticulously planned her schedule, carving out study time before or after her sanitation work shifts. This unwavering dedication paid off when Ms. Poornima successfully completed her Bachelor of Arts degree – a remarkable achievement that showcased her commitment to self-improvement.

News of her accomplishment reached the Akola Municipal Corporation. Recognizing both her academic feat and her potential as a role model, the corporation offered her a unique opportunity: to become a Master Trainer for the Sanitation Workers' Program. This program aimed to equip sanitation workers with additional skills and knowledge to enhance their job performance and safety. While initial shyness arose due to the male-dominated training environment, her eagerness to learn quickly overshadowed her apprehension. She actively participated, soaking up the new knowledge and best practices.

Upon completing her Master Trainer training, Poornima was chosen to lead the training batch for sanitation workers. Standing confidently before her peers, she shared her personal journey of juggling work and studies. Openly discussing the challenges and the importance of self-discipline, her story resonated deeply with the participants.
